

Alumnae Achievement Award

The Alumnae Achievement Award, normally presented during Alumnae Leadership Council in the fall, is conferred upon alumnae who personify the value of a liberal arts education and who have brought honor to themselves and to R-MWC through their outstanding accomplishments. The award may be conferred each year, though not necessarily. No more than three may be awarded in one year.

The Alumnae Achievement Award Committee, which meets in the spring, consists of administration, faculty, trustees, and alumnae representatives. The President and the Director of Alumnae serve ex-officio.

There is no age limit set for the recipients. They must, however, have been out of college for ten years. Each recipient must be present to receive her award.

All alumnae are urged to send suggestions for candidates to the Alumnae Office where files are maintained. Candidates' files, which are confidential, will be kept for five years and will be considered each year.
