The Alumni Achievement Award is conferred upon those who personify the value of a liberal arts education and who have brought honor to themselves and the College through their outstanding accomplishments.

The Alumni Achievement Award Committee consists of administration, faculty, and alumni representatives. The President and the Director of Alumnae and Alumni Relations serve ex-officio.

There is no age limit set for the recipients. They must, however, have been out of college for a minimum of ten years. Each recipient must be present to receive the award.

All alums are urged to send suggestions for candidates to the Office of Alumnae and Alumni where files are maintained. Candidates' files, which are confidential, will be kept for five years, and will be considered each year.
