Physical Education and Health

The physical education and health major and Licensure Program is dedicated to preparing high quality physical education and health professionals who meet and exceed State Department licensure standards. Students enrolled in this program will engage in courses based in a strong liberal studies tradition designed to build pedagogical knowledge, critical thinking, moral reasoning and commitment to teaching. Learning to teach physical education and health is an active process and to become a successful teacher, one must be skilled at critical thinking, independent decision making, and strategic thinking.

Note: This major is open only to students seeking the preK-12 Physical Education Teaching License and making adequate progress in the Teacher Education Program. Students must complete an application for entry into the Teacher Preparation Program prior to declaration of major. In Virginia, licensure may be earned to teach both physical education and health from pre-kindergarten through grade 12. There is no separate license to teach just physical education or just health.
