

Student Teachers' Dispositions Inter Rater Reliability Results

Intra Class Correlation (ICC) estimates and their 95% confidence intervals (CIs) were calculated using SPSS (version 26) based on a mean-rating ($k = 2$), absolute-agreement, 2-way mixed-effects model.

In addition to conducting the intra class correlation estimates, we also computed a simple percentage agreement for raters in each disposition category, with the following results: sensitivity (69.524%), collaboration (58.667%), respect (73.333%), lifelong learning (68%), professional development (63.333%), decision-making (73.333%), diverse learners (66.667%), and excitement (80.000%).
