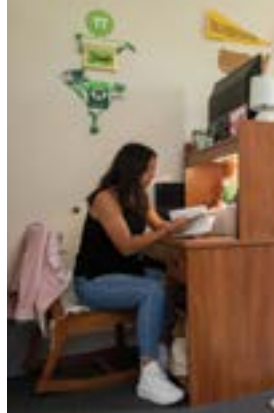


# Home AWAY FROM HOME.

If you scored below 500, we will accept a 79 on the TOEFL, 6.5 on IELTS, 100 on the Duolingo English Test, or 54 on the Pearson Academic.
