The U.S. Department of Education has indicated that you have received Total and Permanent Disability (TPD) discharge, you have applied for TPD discharge, or you will be applying for TPD Discharge.

If the Department of Education grants a TPD discharge of your federal student loans or TEACH Grant service obligation, you will not be eligible to receive a new Direct Loan, Perkins Loan, or TEACH Grant in the future unless you provide:

- 1. A certification from your physician that you are able to engage in substantial gainful activity. This certification must be on letterhead.
2. A notarized statement acknowledging that the new FSA loan or the TEACH Grant service obligation cannot be discharged in the future on the basis of any present impairment, unless that impairment deteriorates so you are once again totally and permanently disabled.

You must sign a new notarized statement each time you receive a new loan. (please initial)

I certify by signing this document that all of the information on this form is complete and true. I understand that if I purposely give false or misleading information, I could be fined, sentenced to jail, or both.
