"All-American": New Perspectives on American Art at the Maier Museum of Art at Randolph

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In this project we will develop a proposal to reinstall works of art in Gallery 1 at the Maier Museum of



Art. We will design the reinstallation based on a question posed in Jaune Quick-to-see Smith's print All-American: "Can you tell me what All-American means?" (1996). We will design an installation that juxtaposes contemporary and historical American art to raise questions and encourage dialogue among museum visitors as to how the concept of "All-American" has been defined, challenged, and revised by American artists (a category this reinstallation will also interrogate) since the nineteenth century. We will conduct research and write a detailed exhibition proposal that includes a checklist, wall text, didactic object labels, a curatorial statement that provides context for the

reinstallation, and a 3D scale model of the gallery reinstallation.
